Specific Action 8.1: Deliverable

- Action is index with keywords from original CV ontology
 -hierarchy of links is generated from .bib file
- Uses both focussed review papers and Cognitive Vision project sites -target 40/month (2 full working days)
 initial utility to convert bib to html (70 item test set)
- So far has 300 processed with 500 planned for first year ending October 2003 -ontology? -format? -more utilities?



Specific Action 8.1: Model

- Take flat index word list & create folder/submenu structure using chosen ontology
- Leaf nodes can enclose 3 entries: bibtex entry, abstract entry & url link to download paper
- 6 Top Nodes: representation; recognition; reasoning; task control; learning; case studies.
- Utility for self-submission open after yr1? Self-sustaining?
